

Figure 8A: Drivers of change, time to impact on business models Share of respondents, %





Real Life Example

- Consumer Products Industry had about 500 material handles in a facility of about 2800 employees
- In 2003, an AGV (Automatic Guided Vehicle) project was introduced and eliminated them all
- A small team of 70 electronic technitians was hired to mantain and operate the new automatic system in 03 shifts.
- Job reduction: 86% in one single year


